I do not speak for all GVE dog walkers, pedestrians or joggers, but this is what I have experienced the last couple of years. Morning walks are beautiful including watching the sunrise, listening to birds sing, hawks calling, and squirrels and rabbits scampering across the road. The fragrance of a flowering plant enhances a pleasant morning, too, when you can say hello to a neighbor, wave to a friend, or receive a courteous nod from a passing motorcyclist. I know it's a law that we should walk facing traffic, however, I choose to walk on the side of the street that is safest for my dog and me. I walk facing traffic as often as I can. Occasionally, while on a daily walk, we have been yelled at..."you are trespassing, get that dog off my lawn" or someone hollering down the street at me "we don't like dogs on our lawn" (my dog was not on their lawn). I am respectful of those requests and avoid walking certain streets or I walk on the other side of the street. Evening walks are more of a concern because motorists just do not see you, even if you are equipped with a flashlight or reflective gear. Frequent walkers and those on bicycles also see two other laws that are not always observed - the speed limit and stopping at stop signs. There are several major intersections that are of concern, so please be aware of pedestrians and bicycles. Let's all make a New Year's resolution to

be more aware and respectful in sharing the roads and keep GVE a safe and enjoyable community.
